The evenings concert from Horseguards was fantastic. The next event to finish the War, is VJ Day on 15 August.







#### **Jobs for June**

Weed, water, mulch! Feed tomato plants when the first fruit sets and pinch out their side shoots. If you leave these shoots then energy will be diverted into them rather than your crop of fruits. Of course there are always exceptions to rules - don't pinch any side shoots off your Otter Tumbler tom. Tumblers work better for you, as little bush shaped plants.

Mid summer's day should be the time to stop cutting asparagus, give it some well-deserved food and let the shoots grow and flourish until they go brown in the autumn. This will give them a chance to make food for themselves and hopefully give you a good crop in 2026.

If you haven't already done it, build supports for climbing beans and...... keep sowing quick growing salad crops such as radish. They are delicious fresh from the garden. Dead head flowering plants to promote the production of more flowers.

Don't forget to tend some of your crops and flowers so that they are ready for our Annual Show on the 2<sup>nd</sup> August! More about the show in next month's Calendar.
