Talaton Parish Council Report

The following are major items from the minutes but a full copy of the minutes may be viewed on both Parish Noticeboards and on the Parish Web site www.talatonparishcouncil.co.uk

Correspondence:

Cllr Hawkins read out a letter from Cllr Lenehan welcoming Cllr Wood to her first meeting.

Items of correspondence

- 1. Letter from Mr Hodge re Talewater Mill Planning application- as the application had gone to planning committee the applicant contacted the PC to see if it would be able to issue a statement at the planning committee meeting on 14th June to back up the support shown on the original planning page. Cllr Lenehan attended the Zoom meeting to support the application. A change in planning rules which would have allowed the development were due to change in a month's time, in light of this the application was granted.
- 2. Paytherden Solar Farm update- letter circulated. Public exhibition delayed due to the Covid restrictions not being lifted.
- 3.Housing Needs Survey- letter circulated. A housing needs survey is due to be distributed to households, it was made clear to the Councillors that this was in fact from a private company and not Devon Communities Together as per the letterhead and letter

Items of late Correspondence:

- 1. The Wildings invitations received for the opening celebrations of the new school on Saturday 10th July.
- 2. Letter from Phil Morgan NHO- Councillors were very sorry to hear that Phil Morgan has been promoted and will be replaced as the Neighbourhood Highways Officer. A letter to be sent thanking him for all the assistance he has given over the period that he had looked after Talaton. He will be greatly missed as he had shown a very hands-on approach and had worked closely with Cllrs Hawkins and Peters in resolving many issues that arose in the village.

To consider Planning Application: 21/1595/AGR – Lower Westcott Farm- – extension of existing silage pit by 45 metres. As this is a prior notification the PC will not make a comment until the application goes to Planning.



To discuss Queen's Green Canopy and Jubilee Celebrations- it was suggested that a beacon could be lit at Beacon Cross and a tree planted on the site. Cllr Hawkins proposed that the item be put on the next agenda when Cllr Lenehan will be in attendance.

Update on the new website – the new website is now live with a greatly improved layout There are still a few more small updates which Cllr Gray is working on; however, the majority of the work has been carried out by Cllr Lenehan and thanks to her hard work the site went live on the 1st July

Parish Maintenance: Items requiring attention and update on items reported – The following matters to be reported to Highways Rydon Cottages – 1 pothole near the top of the hill Pothole- halfway between Beacon Cottages and Talaton Farm on right hand side

Larkbeare – erosion on new road surface between Larkbeare Cottages and Larkbeare Grange caused by running water- check to see what is being done about this.

Sign at Beacon Cross- sign for road brow of hill is still down, report again The sign below Talaton Farm Cottage has been hit and is turned round- Cllr Peters will have a look to see if he can fix it. The hedge between Beech House and Orchard Close to be added to the strimming list.

Items for information only or discussion on the next agenda

(Defibrillator- The shop defibrillator had been taken but not used, both checks completed; Drop -In date – restrictions permitting the next drop in will be Saturday 25th September 10.30am till noon; Wildlife Friendly Village – no suggestions or comments received; Allotments- the 3 gates for the allotments have not yet been made, it was proposed that 3 gates be bought from Blamphayne at an approx. cost of £35each. The Clerk will make enquiries and also for the fitting of the gates. Proposed by Cllr Gray, seconded by Cllr Walker; Riverwood Farm – the enforcement officer confirmed that the condition in the planning permission that was granted does apply for the removal of the temporary dwelling; Escot Go Kart track - the enforcement officer has confirmed that a licence is required for the track, clay pigeon shoot and the other activities. Environmental Health are due to visit regarding the noise levels coming from the site, planning application has still not been received by EDDC. The matter is in hand with the Enforcement section.







Adults will be awarded their trophies at our AGM in November when there will be more space available in the Hall.

Don't forget to keep dead heading your flowering plants to encourage more flower buds to form, and......Don't forget pests will happily share or even decimate your crops. Slugs and snails came out in force after the rains last month and aphids multiplied by the million once soft new rose buds and sweet pea flowering stems appeared. If you keep encouraging birds into your garden, especially with a constant supply of water, they will help control many insects, slugs and snails.



Rainfall at the Cobblers & Parish Hall 100 Club

Rainfall at the Cobblers in Talaton during June 2021.

June 2021 The first part of the month was dry and warm, in the first 15 days I measured only 1mm of rain! The second half of the month we however saw some heavy showers and I recorded 50mm or 2 inches between the 16th and 30th. The were 21 days when no rain fell.

For the whole month I measured 58mm or 2.30 inches which was just under half we had for the whole of May!

The Met Office tells us that the mean temperature for the UK was 1.2C above the long-term average. Most areas in the SW and Wales had a dry month with less than a third of the normal rain, while in the SE of England many places had more than double the average.

Here are some of the UK's extremes for June. A high of 29.7C was recorded in Bushey Park in London on the 14th in Altnaharra, in Sunderland, Scotland they had -2.4 C on the 2nd.

In the 24 hours of the 28th just under 3 inches of rain fell on Princetown on Dartmoor.

Our yearly total now stands at 17.99 inches.



The Adult Group

This group is open to performers aged 14 years and above and will be working on a play entitled "Talaton, A War-Time Refuge". This large cast play tells of the billeting of 23 Polish Jewish Kindertransport children in Talaton during the second world war and, in particular, re-tells the experiences of six of these children. The play, following extensive research, has been written by Tom Samson and is based upon interviews with and the writings of those six children and additional major contributions from their families. Extensive archive photographs and documents will be projected throughout the performances. This amazing and very uplifting story had almost been lost to memory and its recreation and the realization of all that the villagers of Talaton did during this time is certain to leave audiences in total awe and admiration of those who lived here at the time. This project will be launched at an Introductory Workshop in Talaton Parish Hall on Saturday 2nd October between 10.30 and 3.30. Attendance at the workshop does not commit anyone to participating in the production. Come along and find out for yourself and then decide if you wish to be involved. This workshop will include a full reading of the play during the afternoon session. Weekly rehearsals will take place on Tuesday evenings between 7.00 and 9.30 beginning on Tuesday 5th October.

The Children's Group - Young Community Theatre 4All

This group, which will meet in Talaton Parish Hall between 4.30 and 5.30pm, is open to children between the ages of 8 and 13. At first the sessions will be based upon developing Drama and Performance skills, confidence, trust and friendship and when the group is ready it will begin working on a production of "The Little Prince" – an adaption of the children's book by Antoine De Saint-Exupéry. When these rehearsals begin the group will meet from 4.30 to 6.00pm.






