

When inside keep your distance but please wear a mask and bring a flask.



Rainfall at the Cobblers in Talaton during October 2020.

October began with Storm Alex so we had strong winds and a lot of rain and the first frosty nights of the winter. In the first 4 days of the month I measured 60 mls. or 2.4 inches of rain! The middle part of the month was more settled, but with the arrival of storm Barbara it became again wet and windy. The Met office said it was a little colder than normal and for the greater part of the UK, it was a dull and wet month, with 142% of average rain and only 72% of average sunshine. London had 200% more rain than usual!

Writtle in Essex had the highest recoded temperature of 19.1C on the 8th and Tyndrum in Perthshire had the coldest day -33C on 13th. 127ms or over 5 inches of rain fell in 24 hours at a place called Fetlercairn in Scotland on the 4th.

Here in Talaton I measured 168 mls. or 6.72 inches of rain, there were 8 days with no rain and our yearly total now stands at 34.3 inches.





Why are we doing this?.....





Talaton Parish Council Report

The following are major items from the minutes but a full copy of the minutes may be viewed on both Parish Noticeboards and on the Parish Web site www.talatonparishcouncil.co.uk

A Remote Planning Meeting was held on Wednesday 23rd September 2020


To consider Planning Application 20/1266/FUL - Wildwood Wildlife Park Escot Park - These amendments relate to Provision of additional information relating to the proposed overheard walkway, decking and ponds. Also, the provision of further arboriculture details and other supplementary information. Revised application description to read "Construction of Bear enclosure, including the erection of a building for use as a Bear pen, the creation of 2no. ponds, the provision of a keeper escape area, and the construction of decking and an aerial walkway" -following consideration the following response to be sent to EDDC, proposed by Cllr Samson, seconded by Cllr Lenehan – *The PC stands by its original decision and comments as the newly submitted documents do not change what they saw during the site visit. The Councillors feel they do not have the technical knowledge or expertise to comment on the Method Statement and will leave it up to EDDC who have the greater knowledge and expertise on the arboreal and other technical matters.*

Matters of Urgency – items not on the agenda to be discussed at the Chairman's discretion

- 1. Letter received from a resident re the priority given to certain roads for repair. The resident is concerned about damage being caused to his property by the state of the road. Highways have indicated that there may be an underlying problem causing the damage to the road which needs to be addressed before the repairs can be carried out. The PC to look into the matter further and find the root cause of the problem which is damaging the road. Letter to be sent to the resident explaining what action is being taken.
- 2. Letter from Resident re gateway at Larkbeare and response from the landowner. The PC take on board the landowner's points re the gateway always existing and while it may not be a planning matter there are serious concerns over the road safety aspect as the gateway is blind coming from both directions. The matter to be referred to EDDC.

A Remote Meeting of the Parish Council was held on Wednesday 7th October 2020

To discuss arrangements for Grant Giving Evening - Due to Covid restrictions the public Grant Giving Evening will not take place this year. Grant Applications can be submitted by email and for this year the PC will vote for the awarding of

the Grants. Notice to go in the Calendar and on the various noticeboards.

Parish Maintenance: Items requiring attention including updates – The Chairman will write to the CEO of South West Water regarding the problem of the water which is causing the problems with the road outside the shop and Inn. Highways are willing to fix the road but only once the water problem has been fixed.

Items for information only or discussion on the next agenda-Defibrillator-checks completed; the yearly allocation for sandbags has been made and Cllr Hawkins has kindly agreed to collect them; there have been no PC Drop-ins due to Covid however a notice to go in the Calendar asking residents to email any comments or concerns to the PC

A Remote Meeting of the Parish Council was held on the 4th November 2020

Correspondence or verbal communications:

Church Lane- there had been a report of the lane being very slippery due to fallen leaves and acorns. Cllr Lenehan thanked Cllr Samson for very quickly clearing the lane to make it safe. After checking with DCC it was ascertained that the lane comes under Highways.

Change to recycling centres- several recycling centres are now accepting electrical items for resale.

Items of late correspondence

Planning -Talewater Mill- Flood Assessment report. No additional comment to be submitted

Parish Maintenance: Items requiring attention including updates – Potholes at Rydon Cottages and on the way to Blue Anchor have been reported. The fallen branch near Beacon Cottages had been cleared promptly by Highways.

Issues to be reported to Highways-

Pothole- middle of the road opposite the Moor

Pothole – middle of the road near junction at Newtown Corner

Pothole – top of Moor near water metre

Drains blocked – up from Primrose Bank

Drain blocked – Lashbrook corner

Drain blocked – Lashbrook corner on right hand side before Railway bridge Drain Blocked – Newtown near between noticeboard and 30mph sign near railway bridge Cllr Lenehan to draft letter to SW Water and send to Cllr Samson.

All members have received their Dobies catalogues and hopefully have begun ordering. The discount goes on until August 2021, but some seed supplies might get sold out if you delay.


Back to the garden....

Jobs to do include - pruning apple and pear trees planting bare root trees and shrubs, planting rhubarb and garlic, digging over bare ground and adding well rotted organic matter harvesting leeks, root crops and winter brassicas

Try not to tidy your garden too much, leave homes for insects and seed heads for birds. You will be rewarded with lots more activity on your patch. Redwings have already returned to my holly trees. A good sign Christmas is on its

way. Fieldfares, their larger cousins should be coming too. They love apples even more than our blackbirds do and will really appreciate those windfalls left under trees.

Don't forget to leave some water out for birds and other wildlife. If you have a spare moment,



they will all be good for visiting insects apart from just looking good!

Be assured we will organise events as soon as the government gives us the go ahead next year. In the mean time...


