



Talaton Parish Council Report

The following are major items from the minutes but a full copy of the minutes may be viewed on both Parish Noticeboards and on the Parish Web site www.talatonparishcouncil.co.uk

Meeting 4th May 2022

To elect a Chairman: Cllr Lenehan was proposed by Cllr Walker, this was seconded by Cllr Hawkins, all in favour. There being no other proposals Cllr Lenehan duly accepted. **To receive Chairman's acceptance of Office:** - Cllr Lenehan signed the acceptance of office.

To elect a Vice Chairman: Cllr Hawkins proposed Cllr Walker. Cllr Walker said she felt she was not quite ready to take on the role. On asking for other nominations Cllr Hawkins was proposed by Cllr Boss, this was seconded by Cllr Peters, all in favour.

- To receive and note Internal Audit Report Report received and signed by Mr N. Ralph.
- II. To consider and approve Annual Governance Statement Cllrs considered and approved the statement which was then signed.
- III. To approve and sign Annual Accounting Statement Cllrs approved the statement which was then signed.
- IV. To consider and approve Application for Exemption from Audit- the application for exemption was approved and signed.

All the above proposed by Cllr Gray, seconded by Cllr Wood, all in favour.

V. To set date for Public Rights Notice – dates for displaying the notice commence on Monday 13th June 2022 until Friday 22nd July 2022.

Correspondence/ Verbal communications received:

Neighbourhood Plan – email from a resident enquiring if there was a Talaton Neighbourhood Plan. Cllr Lenehan had replied that following a public meeting with a representative from EDDC, given the lack of interest, plus the huge task and cost of creating a Neighbourhood Plan (two years of work requiring the help of a large team of volunteers and several thousand pounds) the PC had decided not to proceed.

New Barn Farm – email from Elgin Energy- change of name for the Solar Farm also an offer to meet with the PC to which Cllr Lenehan had responded thanking them for their offer to update the PC on the plans but pointed out that until they are submitted as an official Planning Application, such notifications are irrelevant. The PC has no authority outside of a PC meeting, and cannot have private meetings of any kind. It would seem more appropriate to share the amendments with the local residents, rather than the Parish Council.

Thank you to all those who contributed to our plant stall on 7th May and to those who came to buy. There were some really choice plants on offer. I hope you kept watering them wel,l to give them a good start in what turned out to be quite a dry period. You helped us raise £149.50 which will help with the expenses incurred for our Annual Show and Pumpkin Competition.

Jobs for June weed, water, mulch! Feed tomato plants when the first fruit sets and pinch out their side shoots. If you leave these shoots then energy will be diverted into them rather than your crop of fruits. Of course there are always exceptions to rules - don't pinch any side shoots off your free Otter Tumbler tom. Tumblers work better for you, as little bush shaped plants.

Mid summer's day should be the time to stop cutting asparagus, give it some well deserved food and let the shoots grow and flourish until they go brown in the autumn. This will give them a chance to make food for themselves and hopefully give you a good crop in 2023.

If you haven't already done so, build supports for climbing beans.

Dead head your annuals and perennials to promote more flowers.

Don't forget to tend some of your crops and flowers so that they are ready for our Annual Show on Saturday 6th August! More about the show in next month's Calendar, but in the mean time how about taking a day off and joining our trip to Greenway on 25th June. Sign up and pay in the Community Shop.

Being of the generation that grew up in the shadow of World War 2, I have always studied it and visited many places in pursuit of my interest. I have visited

Auschwitz, which belies description and is very emotional, so knew the basics of the awful persecution of the Jews by the Nazis and their followers. Before the war started, many Jewish families were trying to leave the countries in Europe for safer places. Many adults could not get on the approved lists to go, but transport for just the children was organised from Germa-





ny, Austria and Poland under the Kinder Transport system.

Only the children were allowed to leave, imagine the heartache of the parents having their families split and children removed, to another unknown (to them) country that would take them. Imagine the impact on those young children torn from their parents to go to who knows where.......

Tom Samsons "Play A Wartime Refuge" which was staged here recently, is the story of just some of those Polish children who came to this country seeking refuge. A story largely unremembered in this village. A story of unimaginable sadness for the children and of the kindness shown to them by the Village in their hour of need. Gerd and Manfred Korman, pictured on the front cover are two of the three boys and three girls who came here, and the story mainly covers their experiences.



A Drama group for children in school years 4 to 9

About Young Community Theatre 4All

Following the highly successful Community Theatre 4All production of "Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat" in March 2020 when a cast of 30 adults were joined by 20 children it was obvious that we needed to open a group for younger members. After a long pause, caused by Covid, the children's group was formed in October 2021 and gave their first performance of an original piece based upon the children's book "Where the Wild Things Are" by Maurice Sendak.

Next year the group will be working on a major piece of children's musical theatre called "Rats!" – an up-beat retelling of the story of "The Pied Piper of Hamlyn". Rehearsals for this show will begin in October.

For children who wish to be involved in "Rats!" this is the time to join the group, to come and make friends and discover what working with Frances and me is like. In the months of May, June and July the group will meet in Talaton Parish Hall from 4.30 to 5.30 on the first Tuesday of the month. Each of these summer sessions will be independent of the others, so if your son/daughter is unable to attend one of the sessions that is not a problem. There will be no meetings in August or September and from October the group will meet every Tuesday in Talaton Parish Hall, initially from 4.30 to 5.30 but then as rehearsals develop the group will go on to 6.00pm. There will be no charge for the Summer Term 'Taster Sessions' but in the Autumn and Spring terms there will be a charge of £25 per term to cover hall hire fees and contribute towards the production expenses.

Young Community Theatre 4All is lead by Tom and Frances Samson, both experienced retired teachers. Tom was a Drama and Theatre teacher and both Tom and Frances have enhanced DBS clearance.

For this project the group will be joined by Julia Green. Julia is well known and respected for her musical work in Whimple, the surrounding villages and in Exeter.

30th Anniversary Events



Rainfall at the Cobblers in Talaton during April

The April showers were in short supply during last month. The UK in general had 3rd less rain than normal.

In the early part of the month15ms of rain in the first 10 days, there after we only had a further 8ms until the end of the month. Our total rain in April was 23ms or 0.95 inches!

The highest temperature recoded by the Met office was 23.4C in St James Park, London on the 15th, and the lowest was -8.0C recoded in Tilloch Bridge in Inverness-shire on the 1st. on the 4th 62.4ms or just over 2½ inches fell at Achfary in Sunderland and 10 cm of snow fell on Redesdale Camp in Northumberland.

Here in Talaton during April we had 22 days with no rain, 4 nights of frost and our yearly total now stands at 6.91 inches.
