March is an exciting time in the garden. Weather permitting, it should be the time to start sowing many of those seeds you have bought, well some of them at least. Broad beans, broccoli, cabbage, leek, peas and spinach will all germinate at fairly low temperatures, but don't be too impatient, there are 31 days in March and hopefully the ground will start warming up enough for lots more. It is a good time for onion and shallot sets, if you have not already planted them. You could also put your early potatoes in.

Trim up perennial herbs such as rosemary and sage and propagate chives and mint by digging them up, dividing them and replanting.

If you still have time on your hands you could begin to prepare beds for sowing and planting in April, but remember that if the weather is kind to us the new leaves will be opening and ready for the first aphids of the year. It is worth keeping an eye out for them and acting before they have multiplied.

If you are still planning to plant bare root fruit bushes or trees it really is your last chance this year, while they are still dormant



Don't forget to check your rhubarb, if you have

put forcing cloches over it. Then what about sit-



ting back to enjoy the first tender crop?

Remember to keep encouraging the birds. Many will repay your kindness by reducing the insect pests in your garden throughout the year.





## EDDC – REVIEW OF POLLING DISTRICTS AND POLLING PLACES INFORMATION HAS BEEN E-MAILED TO COUNCILLORS

The Council was happy with the Parish Hall as its polling station and had no comments/representations to make

#### VILLAGE GREEN (THE MOOR) – UPDATE RE RENTAL PAYABLE; VONEUS BROADBAND AND ANY OTHER MATTERS AND TO MAKE DECISIONS (AS REQUIRED)

The Clerk had now received banking details in order for the Council to make the  $\pounds 5$  annual rental payment which it was required to do under the terms of its lease. It had been reported that Voneus had laid broadband cabling across the Moor

#### GROUNDS MAINTENANCE CONTRACTS UPDATE

The Clerk reported that both three year contracts had been signed by Matt Kingdon and Andy Hazeldine

i. The potholes adjacent to Escot had now been filled and the road was now in a good state of repair. It was **AGREED** that an e-mail of thanks be sent to Kyle Walker the new DCC Highways Officer and at the same time let hm know that two sandbags in the vicinity of the filled potholes required collection.

ii. From  $4^{th}-8^{th}$  March the road from Larkbeare Cross to Talaton Farm Cross – road from Beacon Cross to Talaton Farm Cross – road from Talaton Farm Cross to Fairmile Inn would be closed for cabling works

iii.From 11<sup>th</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup> March the road from Larkbeare Cross to Straightway Head, Whimple would be closed for cabling works

iv.DCC had advised that the sign at the junction of Newtown was now pointing in the right direction

v.DCC had acknowledged the reports of the road requiring repair from Talaton Farm Cross to Fairmile Inn; the pothole on land past Moor farm and the potholes in the lane opposite the Parish Hall


