Talaton church update

As I write this update, the church is reopening its doors to the public for the first time in several months, and the Harvest Festival service is about to start! The visitors today, whether they are regulars or visiting for the first time, will discover a far more welcoming building than previously, freshly redecorated throughout, and beautifully lit by a new lighting system which highlights the main features of the church interior, not least the magnificent roof decoration, which previously could only truly be appreciated with binoculars and a high powered torch.

There's a lot more work been done this year which isn't so obvious: the stained glass windows have all been overhauled, to ensure they will remain amazingly attractive features; an outbreak of dry rot in the ringing chamber has been remedied with the result being a beautiful new wooden floor, at the same time as work is commencing to add security arrangements which will enable us to open the chamber to the public whenever the church itself is open - which is pretty much every day!

Less obvious works, both inside and outside the church, are continuing, as and when the specialist tradespeople and professionals are available.

We are proud of what has been achieved, and hope that you will share our pleasure in having such a wonderful church in this lovely village. Please visit. Our thanks go to everyone involved in emptying the church to enable the scaffolding to be erected, then returning the contents at the end, and then cleaning and polishing ready for the reopening! Thanks also to those who do so much to keep the church as it should be, from opening the church in the mornings and closing it in the evenings; to cleaning it and arranging the flowers before every service and often between times, and our bell ringers who remind us all that the church is still here with us!





Planning Meeting held on 23rd September 2022
To consider Planning Application - 22/1909/FUL - Moor Farm,
Talaton- Conversion of a barn to single storey 1-bed dwelling - after a site visit and consideration the following comment to be sent to EDDC - The PC fully support the application which makes excellent use of an existing equestrian building into residential use. Plans have been carefully considered so that the impact on the neighbouring properties is minimal. Proposed by Cllr Peters, seconded by Cllr Hawkins, all in favour.


Meeting held on the 5th October 2022 Late Correspondence –

Planning Application - 22/1921/LBC - Honeysuckle Thatch -proposed single storey extension on south elevation and to include the removal in part of external wall on south elevation to facilitate extension- planning meeting to be held on Friday 14th October at 7pm.

Resignation letter – letter of resignation received from the Clerk. Advert to go on website, Calendar and DALC. The Chairman expressed her thanks to the Clerk for her work and commitment.

To consider Planning application 22/2001/FUL - 18 Woodmans Orchard -Single storey rear extension to include addition of 2 x rooflights – following a site visit and discussion a vote was taken with Cllrs voting to support the application. Proposed by Cllr Hawkins, seconded by Cllr Lenehan, all in favour. The following comment to be sent to EDDC "The PC fully support the application which will enhance and improve the property. There will be no detrimental effect on surrounding properties"

To consider Planning application 22/2043/FUL - 1 Talaton Farm Barns - Conversion of existing attached garage to additional accommodation – following a site visit and discussion a vote was taken with



Cllrs voting to support the application. Proposed by Cllr Hawkins, seconded by Cllr Peters, all in favour. The following comment to be sent to EDDC "The PC fully support the application which will provide enhancement to the internal layout of the house and there will be no impact on neighbouring properties.

Parish Maintenance: Items requiring attention and update on items reported - water leak at Lees Meadow was reported but not yet fixed. The Clerk to arrange for the strimming to be done. Items to be reported -The new road sign at Beacon Cross on the high side towards Talaton has been knocked off the pole. The road around the water meter opposite the Hall is collapsing. Potholes in Rosemary Lane and potholes between the shop and Woodmans Orchard.

Groups from within the Parish, either an existing group or individuals working together, are invited to apply for all or part of the £500 grant available for the benefit of the community.

Applications must be made in writing, explaining why you need the funds, what they will be used for and how the Community will benefit. One representative per application is invited to present their case in person at the meeting.



Rainfall at the Cobblers / Parish Hall 100 Club

Rainfall at the Cobblers in Talaton During September

The first part of September was warm and a bit unsettled in most regions of the UK, it was dry and a little cooler by mid-month and last few days were much cooler. The month was the 2nd warmest September on record dating back to 1884. The average mean temperature for the whole of the UK was 13.4 C which was 0.5 C above the long term average. A temperature of 27.7 C 07 well into the 80s was recorded in Felsharm in Suffolk on the 4th and the lowest of -.7 C was recorded at Shap in Cumbria on 17th. On the 30th over 4 inches of rain fell in 24 hours at Seathwaite again in Cumbria!

Here in Talaton we had 78.5ms. or 3.16 inches of rain during the month, 18 days with no rain and a long dry spell from the 10th to 28th

Our yearly total now stands at 15.7 inches

The October sunshine was surprisingly warm when I planted my garlic this afternoon. Good weather to do all those tidying up jobs in the garden, but also good to just stand and admire the glorious yellow leaves of the hedge maple and paper birch and to listen to the bees still foraging in the Michaelmas daisies, which are looking amazing.

I know I am repeating myself, but if you are having bonfires, don't forget to check that no hedgehogs have taken shelter underneath yours

before you set it alight.

There is still time to plant green manure if you have some bare ground. It will compete with weeds and add nutrients and humus to your soil when you dig it in in the Spring. Broad beans can be planted now to give an earlier crop next year. Beans planted now will not be as readily

infested with aphids as those planted in Spring. If you have not already done so, it is not too late to plant sweet pea seeds or overwintering garlic bulbs and onion sets,.

I hope you all enjoyed the Pumpkin competition and that those of you who did not enter, have been inspired to have a go next year. Results will be published in next month's Calendar.


It is also the time to renew your membership the cost of which has, after many years, risen to £5 per family; and to pick up your Dobies catalogue. If you fancy




